Twin-sized sheets, blankets, bath towels, wash cloths, pillows, deodorant, shampoo, conditioner, soap, lotions, new underwear, new socks, cleaning supplies, paper products, \$45.00 (covers the cost of a night stay at the shelter)

Infants and Toddlers: sleepers, clothing, mittens, hats, nightlights, etc.
