We're children of God who takes away sin. In Christ we abide; our life is in him. We offer forgiveness, seek justice and peace, And reach out to others, that love may increase.






We're children of God and so our delight is living the life that's good in God's sight. One day we'll be like him, transformed from above to sing for eternity God's song of love.





























I know that my Redeemer lives; what joy the blessed assurance gives! He lives, he lives, who once was dead. He lives, my everlasting Head!


